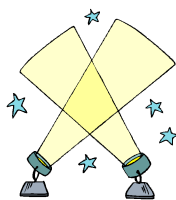

### From the Pastoral Counselor . . .

**Mark 4:37-41 (ESV)** A great windstorm arose, and the waves were breaking into the boat, so that the boat was already filling. <sup>38</sup> But he was in the stern, asleep on the cushion. And they woke him and said to him, "Teacher, do you not care that we are perishing?" <sup>39</sup> And he awoke and rebuked the wind and said to the sea, "Peace! Be still!" And the wind ceased, and there was a great calm. <sup>40</sup> He said to them, "Why are you so afraid? Have you still no faith?" <sup>41</sup> And they were filled with great fear and said to one another, "Who then is this, that even wind and sea obey him?"

Years ago, I went on a fishing trip to Lake Mille Lacs with a group of guys from the church I was serving. We started with a nice breakfast at the resort and then boarded a launch that the resort operated. The wind was blowing pretty good. The big boat was rocking and pitching with the waves. Several of the guys from our group got sick. We saw one fishing boat float past us with its silvery hull side up. We got word that someone had already picked those fishermen out of the water. Even the experienced fisherman were intimidated on those choppy waters that morning.

At least four of the disciples were fishermen; Simon (Peter), James the elder, John, and Andrew. I'm sure that these four fisherman had the experience of being out on the lake when storms arose. The disciples are filled with fear. Jesus is asleep in the stern of the boat. They wake Jesus up and ask Him – "Don't you care that we are all going to die?" When Jesus awoke to their cries – we are told that Jesus rebuked the wind and said to the sea – "Peace! Be still!" Just like that, the wind died down and the water became calm. But this created quite a storm in their spirits. The disciples asked – "Who is this that even the winds and the waves obey him?"

We know who this is? This is Jesus. We face storms in life, storms that may even frighten us to death. Perhaps it seems as though Jesus is sleeping, oblivious to the danger all about you or a loved one. Perhaps you just want to wake him up and ask, "Don't you care?" We know Jesus could do something. We know He has the power to calm the storm. But Jesus asked his disciples, "Why are you afraid? Have you no faith?" The storms we face in life, deepen our faith. What do we really need to fear? Death? Jesus Christ has swallowed up death. We have life, eternal life, by the grace of God. Jesus faced the storm for us. Jesus brings us peace with His father in Heaven through His death on the cross. We don't need to fear. We do have a Savior who cares. We have God's promise in Romans 8 that all things work to the good of those who love God and are called according to His purpose. In Psalm 46, the Psalmist wrote that "God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. Therefore we will not fear, even though the earth be removed and the mountains fall into the heart of the sea."

God is our refuge and strength. This is the one who commands the winds and the waves to be still. This is the one who promises to be with us, even to the end of the age. This is the one who says, "Today, you will be with me in paradise." Let the storms calm within you and know that God is in control.
