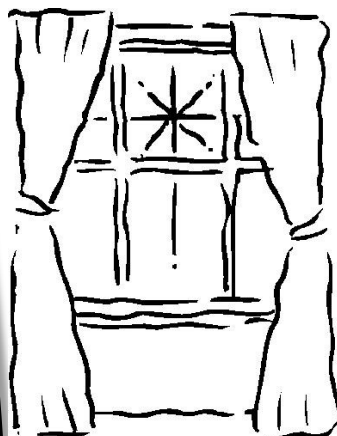

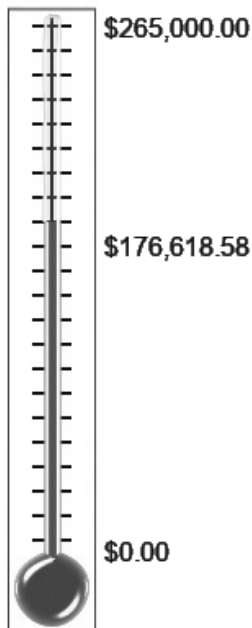

 Hebrews 11:1

HOPE! Do you have hope today? Are you hoping for anything specific? Consider *Hebrews 11:1*, *Now faith is the assurance of things HOPED for, the conviction of things not seen.*

Faith is the assurance. Both aspects of faith, the trust in God's reality and the righteous response, are described as evident together in the Heroes of The Hall of Faith of Hebrews 11.

Some of us are dealing with broken bodies, physical issues, some with broken hearts, others of us never imagined we'd be in a place like this—doubting, struggling, wondering why God seems to have stopped listening and perhaps why He has stopped loving us. We hear the psalmist cry out in Psalm 119, *I am worn out waiting for your rescue...* The English Standard Version states it, *My soul longs for your salvation (Psalm 119:81).* Struggles without HOPE or losing HOPE.

I will tell you that I resonate with and understand more clearly, this issue of HOPE since my accident. It has not been an easy journey, to say the least. My wife will tell you that I went through times of seemingly NO HOPE. I truly struggle to put into words what it feels like to head out for a bike ride and to wake up in the hospital. WHAT IS GOING ON? *Have you ever been there? A difficult, if not desperate situation, powerless to do anything?*

The Psalmist continues, I have put my hope in your word. My eyes are straining to see your promises come true. When will you comfort me? How long must I wait? Psalm 119:84.

Have you ever asked God that question? You know, it is interesting. The Lord did not remove the burden. What is amazing, comforting, and His promise, is that He was and is with us. *Jesus said, "And be sure of this: I will never leave you, even to the end of the age." Matthew 28:20* There is HOPE in Jesus' Words!

I have put my hope in Your Word. It's true, the Word of God is alive and active. God's Holy Spirit works powerfully through His Word. I don't know what your specific burden may be today, but I can confidently prescribe this: Put your hope in God's Word.

Psalm 25:5, Lead me by your truth and teach me, for you are the God who saves me. All day long I put my hope in you.

I have put my hope in Your Word. God was also with me, giving me HOPE through His People—the Church, which includes the church where I serve, and you the LWML family. Building up—Encouraging. What a powerful presence of the Lord!

Have you ever wondered what order you should use to conduct your business meetings?



-- At the start time for the meeting, the Chair or President should call the meeting to order.

Then, here is the **Usual Order of Business in Ordinary Societies** from Robert's Rules of Order Newly Revised:

Optional) Opening Ceremonies such as a prayer or devotion or reciting of pledges such as Pledge of the LWML
Optional) Roll Call

- 1) Reading and Approval of Minutes
- 2) Reports of Officers, Boards, and Standing Committees
- 3) Reports of Special Committees
- 4) Special Orders - usually matters that are required by the bylaws to be considered at a particular meeting, such as nominations, elections, report of the auditing committee, etc.
- 5) Unfinished Business and General Orders (business that is left over from the previous meeting)
- 6) New Business

Optional) Announcements

-- The Chair should ask if there is any other business. If none, they may simply say "Since there is no other business, the meeting is adjourned."

And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another (Hebrews 10:24-25a).
